**Zealous, adj.** *Earnest*: P. and V. σπουδαίος (Soph., *Trag.*), έντονος, σύντονος. *Eager*: P. and V. προθύμος, ὄξυς; see *eager*. *Ready*: P. and V. έτοίμος. *Be zealous*: P. and V. σπεύδειν, σπουδαίειν, προθύμεισθαι, ὀρμάσθαι, V. μαίεσθαι, ἐκπροθύμεισθαι. *Be zealous for*: P. and V. σπουδαίειν (acc.), σπεύδειν (acc.); see *desire*. *Zealous for*: use also V. λελιμμένος (gen.), μαιμών (gen.).
